Welcome to the 2024/25 Winter League

Dear Team Captain

Please find attached all the documentation required for this season. You will find in the package the new *Fixture list*, a list of *Pub and Club addresses*, blank *Game Sheets* for your home matches and two copies of the *Player Registration Form*. Please complete both the forms retaining one for your records and returning the other to me by latest Wk3 Game 3 – Monday, 21st October 2024. Following on from the AGM an up-to-date copy of the BDDL Rules is attached for any new or returning Teams; please make sure that you read and understand all entries

For new Teams to the Winter League the format of play starts with a Gallon of 1001 x 1 followed by six Singles of 501 best of three legs and finally three Pairs of 601 best of three legs. The players' names and running order for the Gallon can be selected by the Team Captain or Contact. A team of 6 should be played. If a team has only 4 or more players, then these should be used in rotation. You are permitted to play as many signed on team members in the Gallon after consulting and agreement the opposing team. A blind draw for the Singles should take place prior to the Gallon. A blind draw for the Pairs should take place after the Singles games have been completed. Please use the provided Game Sheet to show the draw and results. You can enter the number of 120+ throws, indicate with "s" if the 120+ is the players first throw of the leg, a high finish over 100 and any 180's. You are advised that the Winning Team should email the completed Game Sheet to arrive at the following address as soon as possible after the match using a scanned .pdf or readable picture, or by hand or post no later than Saturday am following the match: -

Due to the ongoing COVID-19 Pandemic, we have revised certain Rules.: -

Captain's must take responsibility that any player showing symptoms or returning a recent positive LFT does not attend the Match. The Captain's must also make sure that the Team abides by the rules of the Pub or Club. The use of masks is recommended, as is social distancing.

Some Clubs & Pubs will not be serving food. Review the Fixture List or phone ahead to confirm

Any Team with 4 or more players should play on the night although matches can be cancelled and rearranged, with a valid reason, during the week before. Provision for the rearranged matches will be made at the end of the first half and the end of the season. When a Team plays a Games with 4 or 5 they forfeit the points to the opposing Team, the number of missing Singles and with 4 a Pair. With 5 players a Team is permitted to play the pair with only one player missing a through in rotation.

You are urged to only cancel a game as a last resort. You should look to play the game with a minimum of 4 players forfeiting any untaken games to your opponents. Please refer to Rule 8c.

The last week of the season to sign any new player will be Wk17 Game 12 - Monday, 27th January 2025
